After the success of its preceding editions, Sunday 13 December from 11 to 19 al ghetto contemporaneamente, an event hosted by the galleries of the Ghetto of Rome – Valentina Bonomo Roma, Edieuropa, QUI arte contemporanea, Galleria Pio e Nicola Monti, Ermanno Tedeschi Gallery – unite a community initiative and invite a viewing of their respective shows of contemporary art, each hosting a special event for the occasion.

Valentina Bonomo Roma will inaugurate Pop Up – Memorabilia, rare multiples and pieces only by American Pop artists, curated by Jesus Fuentes.

The show will exhibit not only the most celebrated silk screens that portray objects easily recognizable in our collective memory, but most importantly, products of consumer culture like watches, records, dresses, cans, 3D film glasses, autographed passes from Studio 54 and notes by artists of the caliber of Andy Warhol and Roy Lichtenstein. Also included in *Pop Up* are works by Keith Haring, the celebrated artist who identifies with pop art from a different generation in which the artist traced some of his ideas and his style of life.

These are objects of daily use that become memorabilia thanks to the intervention of artists.

The same concept of memorabilia is established in the spirit that sustains pop art. As Andy Warhol said in an interview with Swenson that appeared in Art News in November 1963 "Pop Art is liking things."
